The Olathe Northwest Raven Dance Team is proud to present the ninth annual Innovative Dance Classic. We are thrilled to be offering a divisional ratings festival to Kansas dance teams, all star teams, independent competitors, and studios. Innovative Dance Classic will feature highly qualified and fair judges, KSHSAA and NFHS rules and regulations, and honest critiques and scoring. School teams will be classified by Varsity, JV, and Middle School for All Around Innovative Awards. Studio/all star groups will be classified based on age. We will still accept virtual submissions as well!

Friday night performances will begin at 4:00pm featuring solos, duets, and trios along with any teams with Saturday conflicts. Dancers may check in beginning at 3:00pm. Teams will be assigned communal dressing rooms on Saturday only. Teams may check in at 7:00am. Studio/all star performances be in the auditorium on the stage on Sunday. *There is a possibility of Saturday performances for studio/all star based on total registration numbers.*

General admission will be \$5 for students and \$7 for adults on Friday and \$5 for students and \$10 for adults on Saturday & Sunday. Each team will receive free admission for coaches and team managers each day.

Categories and Time Limits:

Category	Number of Dancers	Time Limit
Solo	1	3 minutes maximum
Duet/Trio	2-3	3 minutes maximum
Officer Routine	2+	3 minutes maximum
Ensemble	4+	3 minutes maximum
Team	5+ *Acceptable for fewer than 5 dancers if the team is comprised of less than 5 dancers.	3 minutes maximum
Production	Any	9 minutes maximum

Awards

Divisional Ratings:

Each performance will receive a divisional rating. The rating is determined by the average score of the judges (out of 100). Please refer to the table below for score ranges:

Score Sheets:

Each routine will receive a score sheet from three judges on the panel. Score sheets will be available for **coaches** to pick up at the conclusion of the awards ceremony.

Audio Critiques:

Each routine will receive verbal feedback from three judges on the panel. The audio critique files will be shared via DropBox with the director's email listed on your registration form.

Video:

Innovative Choreography will record every performance and provide the video file to you via DropBox.



Awards Continued

All Around Innovative Solos/Duets/Trios:

All solos, duets, and trios are eligible to receive this award based on score. Varsity solos/duets/trios with a score of 90+, JV solos/duets/trios with a score of 86+, C Teams/Freshmen solos/duets/trios with a score of 84+, and Junior High/Middle School solos/duets/trios with a score of 82+ will receive this award.

All Around Innovative Team:

Teams entering two or more team routines are eligible to receive this award based on an average of two highest scoring team routine scores. Varsity teams with an average of 90+, JV teams with an average of 86+, C Teams/Freshmen with an average of 84+, and Junior High/Middle School teams with an average of 82+ will receive this award.

Judges' Choice Awards:

Throughout the day, judges will be awarding **Choreography, Technique, and Entertainment** awards.

Fan Favorite:

All teams will have an opportunity to vote for their favorite routine of the day (not including routines from their own school). The routine with the most votes will receive the Fan Favorite Awards!

Social Media Challenge:

When you send us your team photo, we will post it on our Facebook and Instagram accounts. The team with the most cumulative likes and shares/reposts will receive the Social Media Challenge Award! **Back again in 2027:** You will select a charity to promote during the Social Media Challenge. Innovative Choreography will make a donation on behalf of the winning team to the winning team's charity!

Innovative Exhibition

Before the awards ceremony, select routines will perform again for a packed house at Olathe Northwest! The judging panel will select teams, and the participating teams will be announced throughout the day. What a spectacular way to end a wonderful day of dancing than by supporting one another for one last performance? There will be 2 Innovative Exhibitions: one for Middle School/JV/Varsity and one for Dance Studios.

Inclement Weather Plan

PLAN A

Should inclement weather affect any day of the competition, we will shift the schedule to fit performances on any of the other days. For example, should inclement weather cancel Friday 2/5, all routines will perform on Saturday 2/6 and Sunday 2/7.

PLAN B

Should inclement weather cancel the competition or not allow Plan A to occur, we will shift to a virtual model.

February 12, 2027: All routine videos due to Innovative Choreography.

February 19, 2027: All judge critiques, scores, and placements will be shared with coaches/teachers. Awards will be mailed.

Entries electing to not participate in the virtual inclement weather plan will receive a 50% refund. Coaches/teachers will need to indicate their participation by **February 10, 2027**.

We understand checks from schools can vary on timeliness and often are out of the control of the coach. However, we *must* have a PO in hand on or before 1/15/27. Entries without a PO or payment by 1/15/27 will be subject to a 10% non-negotiable late fee.

***Payment must be received in order for teams/dancers to compete.**

Cancellations & Refunds

- Cancellations received on or before January 14th are eligible for a full refund.
- Cancellations received on or between January 15th-21st are eligible for a 50% refund.
- Cancellations received on or after January 22nd are not eligible for refunds. By 1/22/27, the schedule is finalized and therefore changes would affect the day of the competition (holes in the schedules, awards already ordered, etc).

Virtual Submissions

Upon receiving your registration, Innovative Choreography will reach out to you with details regarding video submissions. Videos must be received no later than January 23rd.



School Rules and Regulations

- All routines have a three minute performance time limit.
- Any routine over three minutes long will be in the production category. Productions may not exceed 9 minutes in length.
- Routines classified as “open” may be divided into sub-categories if there is a need. (EX: If there are numerous novelty entries, a novelty category may be established)
- The Game Day category will follow the same structure as NDA/KSHSAA State. There are three components: performance routine, fight song, and spirit raising performance.
- All music should be submitted via Dropbox. A confirmation email will be sent to confirm the music has been received in working order. Please bring MP3 backups the day of the competition.
- Please ensure all props are padded any portion that will touch the floor so there is no damage to the gym floor. Any damage charges will be billed directly to the violator’s school. Props can be stored in the back hallway near the East Gym.
- Innovative Dance Classic is a family friendly event. Judges will award reasonable penalties for inappropriate movement/choreography (suggestive, thrusting, sexual, etc), music (curse words, suggestive lyrics, etc), and/or clothing (follow KSHSAA guidelines). Innovative Choreography reserves the right to edit (mute or bleep) inappropriate lyrics. All music must follow US music copyright laws.
- We strongly believe in building an enthusiastic, supportive, and positive atmosphere among dancers, coaches, parents, and fans. Innovative Choreography and Olathe Northwest will kindly ask those who do not follow this request to leave the event with no re-admittance nor refund of admission fees.
- KSHSAA and NFHS rules will apply to all Kansas teams. Appropriate penalties will be awarded for not following KSHSAA and/or NFHS rules. KSHSAA member schools will not compete against non-member schools.
- No food or drink (with the exception of water) will be allowed in the dressing rooms or gymnasiums.
- Full payment must be received before Friday, February 5th, 2026. Innovative Choreography & Olathe Northwest reserve the right to remove any routines that have not been fully paid for.
