Categories and Time Limits:

Category	Number of Dancers	Time Limit
Solo	1	3 minutes maximum
Duet/Trio	2-3	3 minutes maximum
Officer Routine	2+	3 minutes maximum
Ensemble	4+	3 minutes maximum
Team	5+ *Acceptable for fewer than 5 dancers if the team is comprised of less than 5 dancers.	3 minutes maximum
Production	Any	9 minutes maximum



School Team Divisions & Studio Group Team Divisions:

Teams will be divided by College, Varsity, JV, and Middle School. Teams may be grouped within each style into separate divisions (example: Small Varsity Jazz and Large Varsity Jazz) based on the number of entries in a style. A split in division will occur if there are 10 or more entries in a style.

Studio/All-Star will be divided by age:

Age Division	Age Range
Tiny	5 & Under
Mini	6-8
Junior	9-11
Teen	12-14
Senior	15-18

Team/Group Styles:

Precision Jazz, Lyrical/Contemporary, Pom, Hip Hop, Mix, Kick, Game Day, Spirit Rally, Prop, Production (3+ minutes)

*There is no limit to the number of styles a team may compete.

Solo Divisions:

Solos will be divided by College, Varsity, JV, and Middle School. Soloists may be grouped into separate age divisions (example: Varsity Freshmen/Sophomore or Varsity Junior/Senior....or even further into Varsity Freshmen, Varsity Sophomore, Varsity Junior, Varsity Senior) based on the number of entries. A split in age division will occur if there are 10 or more entries.

Studio/All-Star will be divided by age (see table above). Solos may be grouped into separate age divisions based on the number of entries (example: Junior 9's, Junior 10's, Junior 11's). A split in age division will occur if there are 10 or more entries.

*There is no limit to the number of solos a dancer may compete.

Duet/Trio Divisions:

Duets/Trios will be divided by College, Varsity, JV, and Middle School. Duets and trios may be separated into separate groups based on the number of entries (example: Varsity Duets, Varsity Trios). A split of duets and trios will occur if there are 10 or more entries.

Studio/All-Star will be divided by age (see table above). Duets and trios may be grouped into separate groups based on the number of entries (example: Junior duets, Junior trios). A split duets and trios will occur if there are 10 or more entries.

*There is no limit to the number of duets/trios a dance may compete.

Awards

Scores & Score Sheets:

Each routine will receive a score from three judges on the panel. The three judge scores will be averaged. Any penalties will be subtracted from the average score. Score sheets will be available for **coaches** to pick up at the conclusion of the awards ceremony.

Team Awards:

Trophies will be awarded to the 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place team in each division.

Solo Awards:

The top 10 soloists in each division will receive a medal. The winner of each division will also receive a trophy.

Duet/Trio Awards:

The top 10 duets/trios in each division will receive medals. The winning duet/trio of each division will also receive one trophy.

Audio Critiques:

Each routine will receive verbal feedback from three judges on the panel. The audio critique files will be shared via DropBox with the director's email listed on your registration form.

Video:

Innovative Choreography will record every performance and provide the video file to you via DropBox.

Regional Champion:

Teams and studios/all-star teams entering two or more team routines are eligible to receive this award based on an average of two highest scoring team routine scores. The College, Varsity, JV, Middle School, and Studio/All-Star Team with the highest average will be named Regional Champion and receive a banner.

Judges' Choice Awards:

Throughout the day, judges will be awarding **Choreography, Technique, and Entertainment** awards.

Fan Favorite:

All teams will have an opportunity to vote for their favorite routine of the day (not including routines from their own school). The routine with the most votes will receive the Fan Favorite Awards!

Social Media Challenge:

When you send us your team photo, we will post it on our Facebook and Instagram accounts. The team with the most cumulative likes and shares/reposts will receive the Social Media Challenge Award! You will select a charity to promote during the Social Media Challenge. Innovative Choreography will make a donation on behalf of the winning team to the winning team's charity!



Innovative Exhibition

Before the awards ceremony, select routines will perform again for a packed house at Ray-Pec! The judging panel will select teams, and the participating teams will be announced throughout the day. What a spectacular way to end a wonderful day of dancing than by supporting one another for one last performance?

Inclement Weather Plan

PLAN A

Should inclement weather affect Saturday, February 20th, we will utilize Sunday, February 21st for the competition

PLAN B

Should inclement weather cancel the competition or not allow Plan A to occur, we will shift to a virtual model.

February 27, 2027: All routine videos due to Innovative Choreography.

March 6, 2027: All judge critiques, scores, and placements will be shared with coaches/teachers. Awards will be mailed.

Entries electing to not participate in the virtual inclement weather plan will receive a 50% refund. Coaches/teachers will need to indicate their participation by **February 24, 2027**.

We understand checks from schools can vary on timeliness and often are out of the control of the coach. However, we *must* have a PO in hand on or before 1/30/27. Entries without a PO or payment by 1/30/27 will be subject to a 10% non-negotiable late fee.

*Payment must be received in order for teams/dancers to compete.

Cancellations & Refunds

- Cancellations received on or before January 29th are eligible for a full refund.
- Cancellations received on between January 30th-February 5th are eligible for a 50% refund.
- Cancellations received on or after February 6th are not eligible for refunds. By 2/6/26, the schedule is finalized and therefore changes would affect the day of the competition (holes in the schedules, awards already ordered, etc).

Virtual Submissions

Upon receiving your registration, Innovative Choreography will reach out to you with details regarding video submissions. Videos must be received no later than February 13th.



Rules and Regulations

- All routines have a three minute performance time limit.
- Any routine over three minutes long will be in the production category. Productions may not exceed 9 minutes in length.
- The Game Day category will follow the same structure as NDA/UDA. There are three components: fight song, spirit raising performance, and performance routine.
- The Spirit Rally category will follow the same structure as DTU. There are two components: spirit raising routine and performance routine.
- All music should be submitted via Dropbox. A confirmation email will be sent to confirm the music has been received in working order. Please bring MP3 backups the day of the competition.
- Please ensure all props are padded any portion that will touch the floor so there is no damage to the gym floor. Any damage charges will be billed directly to the violator's school.
- Innovative Dance Classic is a family friendly event. Judges will award reasonable penalties for inappropriate movement/choreography (suggestive, thrusting, sexual, etc), music (curse words, suggestive lyrics, etc), and/or clothing (follow MSHSAA and NFHS guidelines). Innovative Choreography reserves the right to edit (mute or bleep) inappropriate lyrics. All music must follow US music copyright laws.
- We strongly believe in building an enthusiastic, supportive, and positive atmosphere among dancers, coaches, parents, and fans. Innovative Choreography and Raymore-Peculiar HS will kindly ask those who do not follow this request to leave the event with no re-admittance nor refund of admission fees.
- MSHSAA and NFHS rules will apply. Appropriate penalties will be awarded for not following MSHSAA and/or NFHS rules.
- No food or drink (with the exception of water) will be allowed in the dressing rooms or gymnasiums.
- Full payment must be received before Saturday, February 20, 2027. Innovative Choreography & Raymore-Peculiar HS reserve the right to remove any routines that have not been fully paid for.
